3rd Grade

- 3 Sturdy Pocket Folders

- 2 Highlighters (No student names)
- 2 Boxes of Tissues (No student names)
- 1 Pair of Scissors
- 1 Pencil Case with a Zipper (no pencil boxes)
- 4 Dry erase markers
- 1 large box of tissues
- Ziploc bags – sandwich or snack size
- Headphones or ear buds– to be used ONLY by your child. We use these almost daily.
- Backpack **without wheels**

- 3 folders (1 for reading ; 1 for writing; 1 for math)
- 1 pack of black dry erase markers (fine tip)

*Accordion file folder (at least 12 tabs) – see below (NO Trapper keepers/binders)

- Backpack **without wheels**
- 2-24 packs of pencils
- 1 pack of colored pencils
- 1 pack of highlighters

- 4 composition notebooks (not spiral)
- Pencil case with zipper (due to lack of space, no pencil boxes)
- Scissors – label with name

- 1 pair ear buds (small enough to be stored in pencil pouch; found at dollar store)
